Notes for this sample schedule:

Art and music study will be scheduled bi-weekly -rotating between the two. Yet, even during the alternate weeks, music and art can be reviewed, maintained or practiced. Notes in the appendix of the complete guides give suggestions on how to continue your studies on those alternate week, along with suggestions for both art and music technique.

Day Five is the designated day for longer nature experiences. It is assumed that shorter nature experiences take place on Days One-Four.

Math, Reading/Phonics, Writing, Art Lessons, Foreign Language Study and other activities such as Handcrafts should be added to the sample schedule shown above. The complete guides do not include these subjects.

IMPORTANT!

This grid reflects the weekly layout for Year Two: The Complete Guide. However, Year Three and subsequent Years will follow the weekly layout set up for the Curriculum by Programs path. This will allow families of either path to have weekly schedules which match. In the near future, I will redo the complete guide for Year Two so that the lessons follow the latter weekly schedule and not this one.
